With reference to above letter received from NSS Programme Advospr Cell, New Delhi, I am pleased to inform you that, NSS Cell, University of Mumbai is hosting a National integration Camp for Women of 250 participants from 28th June to 4th July 2015.

You are requested to depute team of 10 Girl NSS Volunteers alogwith a Lady teacher incharge. The participants is preferably with well conversant with the folk of respective area.

Since the climate in Mumbai will be rainy, moderate during the period, the contingents are advised to carry sufficient clothes, personal articles and necessary medicines with them.

Apart from this, the participants are requested to bring traditional costumes of their region for the daily cultural programme. The volunteers should also bring with them the photo identity cards, NSS Volunteer-ship Certificate duly signed by the Principal, Indemnity Bond along with 2 additional Passport size recent Photographs. Each regional contingent shall also bring along with them the State/University Banner/Flag.

Railway sleeper class rail fare, by shortest route of journey shall be reimbursed to the participants maximum up to Rs. 1500/- to and fro on production of tickets at the venue. The contingent is requested to reach the Camp venue by morning of 28th June 2015 and should book their return journey from Mumbai on evening of 4th July 2015.

For the Participants travelling through **Western Railway**

- ❖ Alight at Bandra/Dadar/Mumbai Central Railway Station. Take a local train and come to Santacruz (East) Railway Station. Take a Bus route no. 318 for Vidyanagri, University of Mumbai OR take Auto rickshaw for Vidyanagri, University of Mumbai (Fare for Auto approx Rs. 30/- to 40/-per auto rickshaw.

For the Participants travelling through **Central Railway**

- ❖ If you are Alighting at Lokmanya Tilak Terminus (Kurla) /Dadar Railway Station. Take a local train or auto rickshaw to reach Kurla Local Railway Station. Come to West side of Kurla Railway Station. Take Bus route no. 318 for Vidyanagri, University of Mumbai OR take Auto rickshaw for Vidyanagri, University of Mumbai (Fare for Auto approx Rs. 30/- to 40/- per auto

- ✓ University Flag
- ✓ Every Member of the team should bring at least one traditional dress of their State
- ✓ As we propose to hold a National Integration, we request the participating team to bring along with them all such material which they feel will be useful in projecting the cultural heritage of their State..
- ✓ Any other material related to the NSS Programmes of the University and State such as Posters, Banners, action photographs etc.
