### Action Plan for celebrating "Constitution Day" on 26.11.2016

#### NYKS (Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan)

- The 'PREAMBLE' of the Constitution of India shall be displayed and the PREAMBLE and the FUNDAMENTAL DUTIES shall be read out, in all NYKS offices. Similarly, the reading of the Preamble and Fundamental Rights may be organised at youth clubs and other levels.
- 'Mock Parliament Sessions' on Constitution of India, shall be organised at Block level, as part of the Neighbourhood Youth Parliament Programme.
- NYKS shall organise Talks/ Lectures by eminent persons, Debates, Essay/ Quiz Competitions, Rallies, etc. on Constitution of India, involving youth club members. NYKS youth club members should also be mobilised for participation in such programmes organised by State Administration.

#### NSS (National Service Scheme)

- The 'PREAMBLE' of the Constitution of India shall be displayed and the PREAMBLE and the FUNDAMENTAL DUTIES shall be read out, in all NSS offices. Similarly, the reading of the Preamble and Fundamental Rights may be organised at the institutions where NSS units are there.
- The Universities having NSS should organise Mock Parliaments and also organise Talks/ Lectures by eminent persons, Debates, Essay/ Quiz Competitions, Rallies, etc. involving NSS volunteers. NSS volunteers should also be mobilised for participation in such programmes organised by State Administration

#### RGNIYD (Rajiv Gandhi National Institute of Youth Development)

- The 'PREAMBLE' of the Constitution of India shall be displayed and the PREAMBLE and the FUNDAMENTAL DUTIES shall be read out, in RGNIYD offices in Sriperumbudur and Chandigarh, also involving students and trainees.
- RGNIYD (and its Regional Centre in Chandigarh) shall also organise Mock Parliaments and also organise Talks/ Lectures by eminent persons, Debates, Essay/ Quiz Competitions, Rallies. Etc.

#### Ministry HQ at Shastri Bhawan
