**Sub:- Voters' Registration and Awareness Drive..**

Dear Sir / Madam,

India is the biggest democratic country in the world. Indian people are enjoying democracy by exercising their precious voting rights. It is observed by Election Commission of India that there is a need to involve Indian youth to strengthen the Indian Democracy. So the Commission directed to all Universities to take active part in Voter Registration and Voter Awareness at the time of elections in the country. As per the guidelines issued by the State Election Commission, Mantralaya, following activities to be conducted for Voter Registration Campaign.

1. VOTER REGISTRATION DRIVE: Voter Registration Drive will be conducted from 16<sup>th</sup> Sept, 2016 to 14<sup>th</sup> Oct, 2016. All College NSS Units / Programme Officer are requested to participate in the voters registration drive. Voter Registration should be encouraged by NSS Volunteers for maximum College students. They are also requested to do voter registration drive in the nearby adopted slum area as well as in adopted village.
2. The NSS Volunteers shall work for 10 hours for voter registration drive as a part of Area or college level project. They will select one housing society for 100 % voter registration.
3. The NSS District/ Zone Co-ordinator shall act as a Nodal Officer for his District/ Zone. Similarly the Area Co-ordinator shall act as the Nodal Officer for the respective area.
4. All Programme Officer shall act as NODEL OFFICER for their College to motivate students and people of nearby area to register as a voter. They will put a banner as "Voter Registration Drive Centre" in their college. (Sample banner attached herewith).
5. From 16<sup>st</sup> Sept, to 14<sup>th</sup> Oct, 2016, every College Nodal officer shall send the weekly report of Voter Registration to their respective District Co-ordinator (enclosed weekly report format).
6. All Programme Officers are requested to contact to the nearby Election Office for the Voter Registration Drive.
7. Mumbai jurisdiction Colleges, NSS Units / Programme Officers, kindly contact Shri. Prabhakar Mohite (BMC) (Mobile No. 9820937028) for required help for Voter Registration Drive.
