Zone / District	Theme

Mumbai Western Suburb	Environment including preservation of natural resources and conservation of cultural / historical heritage
Thane District- Western Line	Education and literacy including legal awareness
Thane District- Central Line	Emergency intervention including trauma care, initial counseling and data collection
Raigad District	Health, Public sanitation and personal hygiene
Ratnagiri District	Rural development including project identification, programme formulation, implementation and evaluation
Sindhudurg District	Rural development including project identification, programme formulation, implementation and evaluation

All the College NSS Units are requested to kindly arrange the programme according to the theme during Special Camp. The NSS Unit / District Co-ordinator may like to take the guidance of well established institutions of the given area for the zone / district and draft an action plan. The action plan should provide some hours devoted for giving the NSS volunteers adequate theoretical /academic input.
